- Dr. Padela is Asst Professor of Medicine in Emergency Medicine and Director of the Initiative on Islam and Medicine here at UC. He conducts community-based research on the ways in which Islamic beliefs, values and identity inform American Muslim health behaviors particularly around breast cancer screening and organ donation. He is also a leading Islamic bioethicist studying how the Islamic moral and legal tradition and traditional scholar engages pressing concerns within bioethics and modern science. He is currently a Templeton Foundation Faculty Scholar and Senior Editor of the forthcoming Encyclopedia of Islamic bioethics, and a former visiting fellow of Islamic studies at Oxford University, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Clinical Scholar.
