- Transgender women of color are at increased risks for poor health outcomes, including sexually transmitted infections and HIV. Additionally, they also encounter disproportionate rates of cumulative stigma, discrimination, alienation, stress, denial of opportunities, exposure to violence, homicide, unresponsive legal systems, social injustice, and limited access to health care. This presentation highlights the social/structural challenges of developing effective HIV prevention interventions that address the multiple health disparities that young transgender women of color face.
